FIRE FIGHTER/EMT JOB DESCRIPTION





Prevents, combats and extinguishes fires, and provides rescue services. As an EMT, examines, treats, and transports sick and injured patients. This position performs multiple tasks in potentially dangerous environments and serves as the first line emergency responder to fire and medical emergencies.

The Firefighter/EMT works directly with a well trained team and reports to a Company Officer, initially assigned to mentoring them during their shift and subsequently guides the daily work of the Firefighter/EMT, with the Battalion Chief providing oversight.

Essential Duties:

- Cares for injured or ill patients.
- Drives apparatus, operates pumps, ventilates roofs, assists with salvage and overhaul operations.
- Participates in community and District sponsored events.
- Participates in drills and training courses.
- Operates portable power and a variety of hand equipment tools; laying hose, connecting lines, and nozzles.

The ideal candidate will be self motivated, able to troubleshoot problems, and remain focused in critical situations. Being a strong communicator, who is able to lead and follow effectively will serve a candidate well in this role.
