The estimated cost range for this project is \$5,400,000 - \$5,800,000

The bids shall include all Work pursuant to the Drawings and Project Manuals, and Addenda as may be issued prior to bid opening date.

The meeting is intended to provide a general review between bidders, owner, and architect prior to bidding the project. Any changes resulting from this conference will be made by Addenda following the meeting.
