
Last year, WA voters passed the Minimum Wage Initiative that also included a requirement for all WA employers to provide a minimum amount of paid sick leave for employees. The legislation (RCW 49.46.210) went into effect January 1, 2018.

Management has been working with labor regarding the administration of this Law that impacts all non-exempt employees. The results are reflected in the attached **MOU #1 - 2018 and an updated SOP 4-01 Sick Leave/Emergency Leave linked below**.

Bremerton Fire and Federal Fire units responded as well.





