

New TeleStaff Roster View

I have created a new [Suppression-on duty] roster view in Telestaff. This view eliminates the KDays, VAC, SL, etc. from the roster, which provides a very clean . . . and printable without having to scale down to 65% . . . option. (90% worked well for today's roster). It is accessed from the standard roster, by clicking on the drop-down menu in the upper right hand corner. The {Suppression-on duty} roster view is the second on the list.

We are continuing to work on improving Telestaff and look forward to adding more functionality in the coming weeks and months!

AO ACADEMY

Last week, 17 current AO's and 2 Volunteer Captains attended the inaugural CKFR AO Academy. We had two days of classroom and one day of practical scenarios.

We covered a wide range of topics: Apparatus Readiness, Pump Theory, Emergency Scene Basics, Field Hydraulics, Drafting, Relay Pumps Operations, Dual Pumping, and Tandem Pumping. During practical evolutions, we relayed pumping using four apparatus. We emphasized correct pump pressures, communication, and teamwork. During the evolutions, we had 1500 feet (1/3 of a mile) of 4 inch supply and flowed up to 1300 GPMs. We also dual pumped (supply two engines off of the same hydrant) and flowed 1200 GPMs using two deck guns.

Overall, it was very successful. It is a dynamic process with a great deal of collaboration. The AO's and Captains who took the class will be bringing the training applications back to their crews and will be using our material to teach others within the organization.




Mock Code Neuro

Last weekend, CKFR participated in the Kitsap Healthy Kids Fair and Fun Run held at the Fairgrounds. LT Kevin Bernt organized this simulation and was assisted by the crew from 41 A-Shift. The scenario illustrated the process of recognizing a stroke in a family member and activating the emergency response through Kitsap 911. The CKFR crew arrived on scene, performed an assessment and "transported" the patient to the hospital where an ER doctor and nurse took over the patient care and explained the importance of early stroke identification.

The scenario itself was very impressive and CKFR received multiple compliments for our professionalism, patience, and expertise!
