

SUBMERGED VEHICLE

On Friday, September 7, A-shift responded to a Motor Vehicle Accident, with the report of a car off the road, upside down, submerged in the water near Brownsville Marina. E41, E51, M51, BN51 responded, with several rescue swimmers as part of the crew. Once on scene, crews learned that the driver was able to get out of the car and was uninjured. CKFR deployed swimmers to ensure all occupants were out and to assess the situation. A resulting fuel/oil sheen was seen on the water, stretching for several hundred yards along the shoreline.

CKFR worked with DEM, Department of Ecology, WSP, KCSO, Port of Brownsville and the U.S. Coast Guard to determine a course of action. Due to the nature of the spill, the Port of Brownsville stretched an absorbent boom across the entrance to Steele Creek to protect the waterway as the unleaded fuel evaporated off the water and dissipated.

CKFR Rescue Swimmers assisted Bethel Towing with attaching chains so the vehicle could be lifted from the water and towed away. They also swam around to collect debris and personal items that were left floating on the water after the vehicle was removed

It was a team effort across all agencies!
