POLICY ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS WILL NOW BE PROCESSED THROUGH TARGET SOLUTIONS!

What's changing?

Effective immediately, only the acknowledgement piece of the process will transition to Target Solutions. CK Share will remain the repository for policies and other official documents (no change).

How will it work?

- When a policy is ready for acknowledgement, you will receive a "New Assignment Notification" email from support@targetsolutions.com. This will contain the name of the policy and a link to log onto Target Solutions.
- Upon logging on, you can access the policy acknowledgement(s) that have been assigned to you from the "Schedule" box on the Target Solutions homepage or the "My Assignments" tab on the left-side menu.
- Once you've read the policy, check to acknowledgement box, enter the date, and submit as complete.

Additional information:

- If you have not yet logged onto Target Solutions, it is important that you do so now by following the instructions in the attached memo (see Sam's email on 3/12/19).
- Please be sure that you've acknowledged all policies that have been assigned to you through CK Share up until March 1, 2019. Those acknowledgements will remain in CK share.
