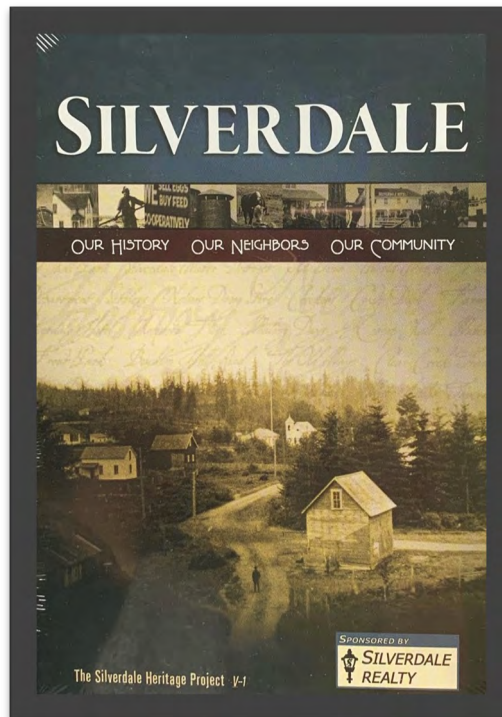

WHAT'S CHANGING?

Training Request and Tuition Reimbursement Request forms (forms 2001, 2001A and 2001B) have been digitized through CK Share's Service Request functionality allowing for automated submission and distribution of the forms.



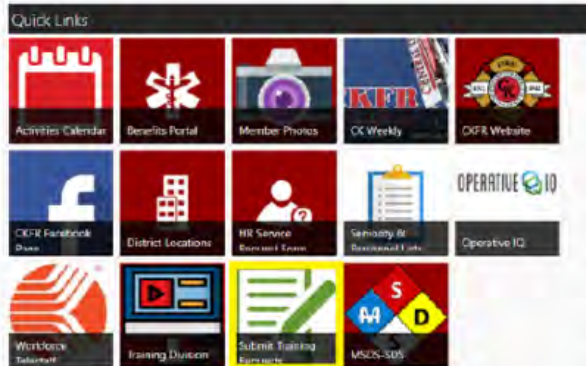
By eliminating the use of these paper forms, the Training Division is able to process requests more efficiently.

HOW IT WORKS

Access the Training Request and Tuition Reimbursement requests through **Quick Links** on the **CK Share Homepage** OR on the **Training Division's Site**.

Complete the form online and submit.

Your request will be distributed through the automated approval process.



TIPS FOR COMPLETING THE FORMS

- The **Request Category** field auto populates the training request form OR the tuition reimbursement request form based off of your choice
- The **Employee Group** field dictates which approval workflow to process the request through (Management team should select Non-Uniformed)
- Be sure to select **Submit** from the request status field and then click **Save** when ready to turn in your request for approval
