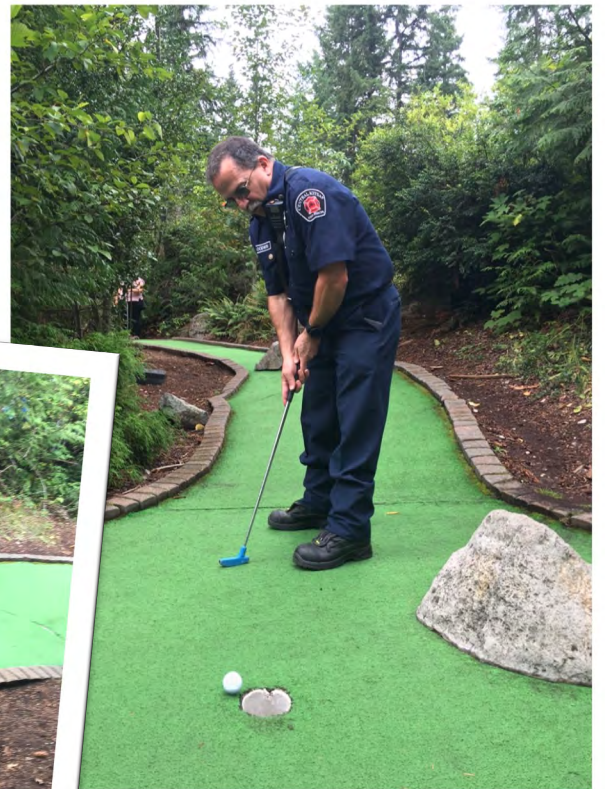
LEFT: On Wednesday, Admin staff participated in the building's back-to-school themed potluck!



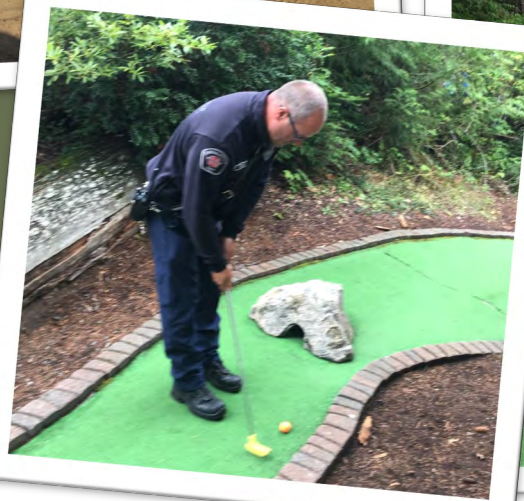
RIGHT: Labor Day found A-shift on site at McWilliams construction site for a large (40' tall!) pile of bark and ground-up stumps that was on fire.

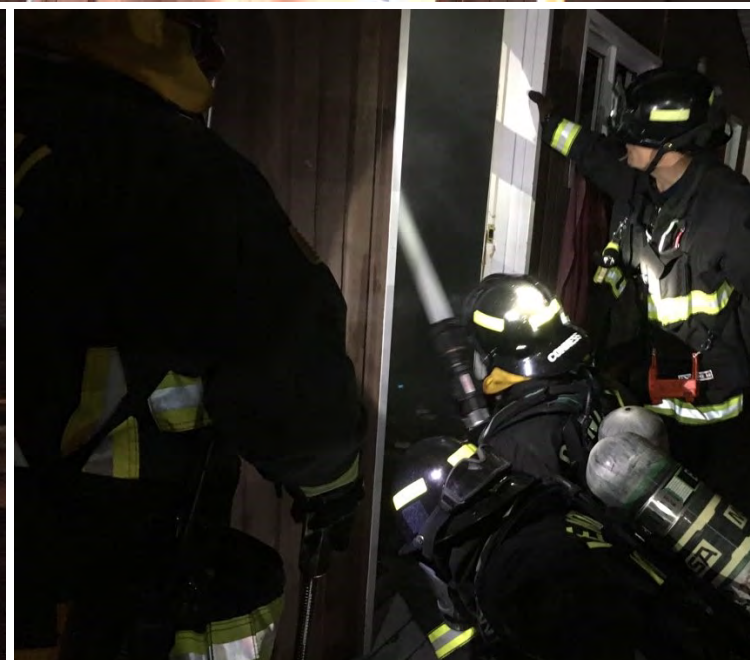




TRAINING @ THE SEABECK CONFERENCE CENTER
