Bond Projects - Update

To: Members of Central Kitsap Fire & Rescue From: Chief John Oliver

As you all know, we are at the beginning of a long journey that will undoubtedly improve our services and the health and safety of our communities. A districtwide upgrade of facilities for an agency of our size is very rare. As we move forward, your input, support and patience will be invaluable to the success of these projects.

We will begin a phased approach of garnering input from not only our employees and volunteers, but the local communities that will be served by each facility. These phases are intended to provide guidance on interior layout, mechanical/electrical, interior and exterior coverings, appliances/furnishing and landscaping/exterior hard surfaces. We will soon identify representatives from each user group and provide them with working documents to collect input from each of you. If you are interested in being a shift or volunteer contingent representative, please reach out.

I also want everyone to understand that we have very strict rules and benchmarks that must be met in regards to allocating bond funds. For example, we must encumber 5% of the acquired funds within 6 months. In the first 30 million dollar bond sale, that will equate to 1.2 million dollars that will need to be spent prior to next June. These spending requirements will make all of the decisions going forward very time sensitive. As your Fire Chief, I pledge that you will have an opportunity to provide input during this process. With that said, please keep in mind that the progress of these projects is predicated on many factors beyond design and layout.

Beginning in January, Chief Mike Tague will become the AC of Capital Projects. His sole responsibility will be to manage all of the bond projects going forward. Some of the pieces will also be handled by other staff members, however, if you have questions, Chief Tague is the point person.
